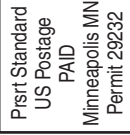

New Lead Regulations, Engineered Products and the Most Frequent Inspection Failures!

**Course Description**

This year's seminar will establish the base for code-built environments that will allow the contractor to have greater success in the office and in the field. Attendance will set them apart from their competitors by providing information that will assist them with solving code-related problems while minimizing delays and costly corrections. This 7-hour seminar will cover the new EPA Lead Renovation, Repair and Painting rule (RRP) that takes effect in 2010.
