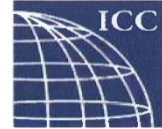

The International Existing Building Code®

(IEBC®) covers repair, alteration, addition and change of occupancy for existing buildings and historic buildings, while achieving appropriate levels of safety without requiring full compliance with the new construction requirements contained in the other I-Codes.

This course will identify key concepts regarding accessible, alterations, changes of occupancy, and additions of existing buildings, including historic buildings. In addition, the discussion will identify the basic minimum scoping requirements as they apply to the accessibility of existing buildings. The learner will receive an overview of the key code changes found in the 2018 International Existing Building Code and address the application of the technical requirements established in the 2009 ICC A117.1 Accessible and Usable Buildings and Facilities.

2018 IBC – Use of Fire Sprinklers & Alarms.

This seminar identifies those conditions under which automatic sprinkler protection and/or fire alarm systems are required. The application of the fire area concept will be discussed, along with the varying extent of sprinkler protection required based upon specific situations. In addition, the discussion will address many of the key code conditions under which the presence of an automatic sprinkler system can be used to modify other requirements. Specific topics include:

- Overview of fire protection systems
- Definition and application of fire areas
- Required sprinkler and alarm protection based on occupancy classification
- Optional use of automatic sprinkler systems.

Upon completion, participants will be better able to:

- Understand the design, construction and application of fire areas
- Identify those conditions under which an automatic sprinkler system is required
- Identify the various types of alarm systems and when they are required to be installed

Determine those situations where sprinkler protection can be used as a trade-off for other code requirements
