

# ANNOUNCEMENT

## UNIFORMITY OF INSPECTIONS COMMITTEE WILL BE LAUNCHING A NEW FORMAT FOR CODE INTERPRETATION REQUESTS.

This new format will be web-based on the 10K Lakes website for all registered Building Inspectors, Building Officials and Code Officials to participate in the code interpretation process.

### **How it will work:**

- Topics are submitted to the Uniformity of Inspections Committee. Based on usefulness and relativity, the Uniformity Committee will select topics for web discussion.
- Topic questions will be posted on the 10K Lakes website for a specified time (probably one month).
- Members will contribute interpretations, code section references and experiences to promote discussion on the Topic.
- Members will have an opportunity to vote their opinions to affect:
  - A code interpretation,
  - A State Opinion, or
  - A code change

The Uniformity Committee will compile the information to create a "Group Consensus" which will be presented to the Department of Labor and Industry Building Codes Division as a full package of interpretations, opinions, and referenced code sections requesting an Official Position or code change.
